The operator of this site declares that it is committed to complying with legal requirements and protecting the personal data of individuals. In the course of its activities, it makes every effort to fully comply with legal obligations and to protect and ensure personal rights, as well as to ensure the right of visitors to informational self-determination.

Our goal is to ensure safe internet surfing for visitors in full compliance with applicable legislation.

With this document, we provide information on the method of data processing in a concise, transparent, understandable, easily accessible and printable form and comply with our legal obligation.

In short:

- We collect and process personal data only in accordance with the law,
- No system messages are sent,
- We do not send advertising (DM) letters,
- The data is stored as securely as possible,
- We do not pass on personal data to third parties,
- Upon written request, we will inform anyone about the data stored about him or her within a short period of time,
- We will modify or delete personal data upon written request.

USER CONTRIBUTIONS

By browsing the website, the User acknowledges that Tamás Fodor e.v. (hereinafter: Author) reads the contents of the intellectual property of the operator of the website and uses it exclusively for obtaining his/her own personal information.

The information on the website can be viewed free of charge, but the Operator of the website, as the copyright holder, does not consent to the free commercial use of the published content.

Regulation 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council (GDPR= General Data Protection Regulation) provides for the protection of personal data of natural persons and the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (hereinafter referred to as the Regulation).

The Regulation stipulates that the Data Controller (in this case Tamás Fodor e.v., owner of the websites) is obliged to ensure the exercise of the rights of the natural persons concerned and to provide the data subject with adequate information regarding the processing of personal data. The obligation of prior information of the data subject is also prescribed by Act CXII of 2011 on Informational Self-Determination and Freedom of Information.

In our Privacy Policy, we specify the method, time and rules of using and storing (data management) the data provided during registration on the websites listed above in accordance with the provisions of Act CXII of 2011 on Freedom of Information, taking into account the recommendations of the Online Privacy Alliance and the relevant international conventions.

Data of the Data Controller

The Data Controller is the one to whom natural persons voluntarily provide their personal data (name, address, email, phone, IP, cookie ID) and manage them (recording, collecting, storing, using, modifying, transmitting) them for a predetermined purpose.

Tamás Fodor also performs the tasks of data protection officer under the GDPR, i.e. he organizes and conducts the data management and data processing activities of the company and, if necessary, also liaises with the data protection authority.

Data of data processors

Processor means a natural or legal person, public authority, agency or other body which processes personal data on behalf of the Data Controller; (Regulation

Art. 4 8.)

The use of a data processor does not require the prior consent of the data subject, but the Data Controller is obliged to inform the data subjects of the fact of data transfer. Accordingly, we provide the following information:

The Data Controller uses data processors to maintain and manage its website, who provide IT services (hosting services, newsletter sender, etc.) and within this framework – for the duration of our contract with it

– processes the personal data provided on the website. An operation performed by IT service providers is the storage of personal data on the server.

Data Processors have their own Data Management Policy, in which they guarantee legal compliance. This fact and our contract with them guarantee that the personal data transmitted is safe.

Information on data processing on websites

The provisions related to data management and the protection of visitors' personal data apply only to natural persons, considering that personal data can also only be interpreted in relation to natural persons (pursuant to Section 3, Section 1 of Act CXII of 2011 on Informational Self-Determination and Freedom of Information).

This document is binding only in relation to the processing of personal data of natural persons.

Anonymous information that is collected without personal identification and cannot be associated with a natural person is not considered personal data, nor is demographic data that is collected without linking it to the personal data of identifiable persons, so that no relationship can be established with a natural person.

We declare that we collect and process personal data only in accordance with the law. The data is stored as securely as possible. No personal data will be passed on to third parties. We take all security, technical and organizational measures that guarantee the security of the data.

The operator is committed to maintaining the quality of the website service at the highest level, but does not assume any liability for any damages arising from the use of the service.

The Data Controller's data protection concept is based on informed voluntary consent, which it strives to implement in all phases of using the service. Its data management principles are in line with the applicable legislation on data protection.

Data processing on the website is carried out by the operator, and data is transferred only to the above-listed Data Processors for a specific purpose. It does not disclose personal data to third parties, it may only do so with the prior and express consent of the data subject.

The personal data collected on the website are not linked by the data controller to data from other sources. The operator does not transfer user data to third countries (abroad). The statements and analyses prepared from the users' data using general statistical methods are kept by the operator for an unlimited period of time. It is not possible to draw conclusions about the data subject from those data.

On the website, the operator does not collect special data about its users (data on racial origin, membership of a national or ethnic minority, political opinion or party affiliation, religious or other philosophical beliefs, membership of interest representative organizations, health, pathological addictions, sex life, as well as criminal personal data).

The author reserves the right to delete users who register with incomplete or false data from the database without warning. The subscriber has no legal remedy or compensation against deletion. The user registers to the database knowing and acknowledging these rules.

Subscribing to the newsletter initiated on the site and downloading any free study constitutes an express acceptance of the terms and conditions of subscription, which the user acknowledges by voluntarily clicking on them.

What personal data do we collect and for what purpose?

Sign up for newsletter

We use the user data voluntarily provided to send newsletters, blog bulletins, and to send our own and occasionally business partners' advertisements. The data is stored in our computing and newsletter sending tools and software, and only backed up and stored there. Access to data is limited and secure.

The personal data received upon registration will be treated confidentially, in accordance with the law, exclusively for business purposes, and will not be passed on to third parties under any circumstances. You can cancel your subscription at any time by clicking on the unsubscribe link in the bottom line of the email you send or by writing to hello@low-glow-flow.com.

During the entire period of data processing (time between registration and unsubscribing), we protect the data against unauthorized access, alteration, disclosure or deletion, or against damage or destruction. Personal data may only be accessed by persons occupying the relevant positions.

Newsletter subscription is voluntary, a two-step, so-called newsletter subscription. It is carried out in an opt-in system. Due to possible abuse, the subscription is only done by clicking on the subscription link sent to the given email address. Letters will not be sent to unconfirmed applicants.

The condition of subscription is acknowledging that you have familiarized yourself with the Privacy Policy and accepting the sending of letters with advertising content (DM).

The data will be stored until the user unsubscribes. By subscribing, the user declares that he/she has provided his/her e-mail address in order to receive letters, mailings and information from the author. In addition to useful information, occasional emails may also contain offers and advertisements promoting the products and services of other business partners. The operator ensures unsubscribing in all its notifications.

The legal basis for data processing is the voluntary consent of the user.

Fill out the contact form

In addition to the name of those who contact us for help on the contact form, we ask for an email address in order to answer the question substantially. The legal basis for data processing is the voluntary consent of the user.

Comments

When submitting a comment, in addition to the information provided in the comment form, the commenter's IP address and browser ID string are collected to filter out unwanted content.

A depersonalized string generated from the email address (commonly called a hash) is transmitted to the Gravatar service if it is used on the site.

The terms and conditions of the Gravatar service can be viewed at <https://automattic.com/privacy/>.

After accepting the comment, the content of our comment and our profile picture will also be publicly displayed.

After writing a comment, the website stores the name, e-mail and web address provided in a cookie (a short, harmless file placed on the user's computer). The storage is for convenience only, so that you don't have to fill it in automatically the next time you post. Cookies expire after 1 year.

The legal basis for data processing is the voluntary consent of the user.

Data from external sources

Posts on this website may use embedded content (e.g. videos, images, articles, etc.) from external sources, over which we have no control. Embedded content from external sources behaves exactly as if you had visited another website.

These websites may collect information about visitors, use cookies or third-party tracking code, monitor user behavior related to embedded content if you have a user account and are logged in to the site.

We have no insight or possibility of intervention over these external data processing, nor can we see the data collected by them, but if we become aware that the data is being handled irregularly by the external service provider, we will delete the embedded content immediately.

Cookies

The website uses cookies to enhance user experiences and personalized browsing. Cookies help us provide the best possible services, a pop-up window informs visitors about their existence. By using this website, the user agrees to the use of cookies.

During the visit to the website, the IP address of the users may be recorded, from which in some cases the person concerned can be inferred, in addition to which the operating system, browser type and the address of the visited page are recorded. Data backup has primarily a technical purpose, it is essential for the continuous operation of the system.

Another purpose of data recording is to analyze user habits and prepare visitor statistics, which helps to provide an even higher level of service. The operator does not link the data obtained during the analysis of log files with other information, and does not seek to identify the user.

The most frequently stored data when browsing the website concerned:

- IP address used by the visitor,
- browser type,
- characteristics of the operating system of the device used for browsing (language setting),
- date of visit,
- the (sub)page, function or service visited, click.

General information about cookies

A cookie is a set of data that the visited website sends to the visitor's browser to store and later reuse to enhance the user experience and make browsing easier. Cookies have different validity periods, they can last until you close your browser or even indefinitely.

The cookie remembers the user, which may also be suitable for tracking the user (accessing them with advertisements on other sites) by the operator of the website or another data controller built into the site (e.g. Facebook, Google Analytics), in which case the content of the cookie can be considered personal data.

Types of cookies and purpose of their use

Session cookies: they are technically essential, without them the site simply would not function functionally.

Usually, only the session-id is stored on the user's computer, the rest of the data is stored on the server, which is more secure. Session cookies are all cookies that are valid for only one session, i.e. they are deleted when you exit the browser.

The purpose of data processing: to ensure the proper functioning of the website, without them the site would not function. The duration of your data processing is limited to a single visit, cookies are automatically deleted from your computer at the end of the session or when you close your browser.

The legal basis for data processing is provided by Section 13/A (3) of Act CVIII of 2001 on Certain Issues of Electronic Commerce Services and Information Society Services (Elkertv.). The law states that the service provider may process personal data that are technically indispensable for the provision of the service for the purpose of providing the service.

Usage cookies: they remember the user's settings and choices. The settings stored in the cookie make it possible not to have to set everything again next time. The data is stored on the user's computer, the website can only access and recognize the visitor.

The purpose of data processing: to increase the efficiency of the service, to increase user experience, to make the use of the website more comfortable. The legal basis for data processing is the consent of the visitor.

Performance cookies: collect information about your behaviour, time spent and clicks on the website. These profiling cookies are typically third-party applications (e.g. Google Analytics, AdWords, Facebook).

For statistical analysis, we use Google Analytics, Google's widely available web analytics service. Google Analytics cookies can be used to compile demographic and other reports from the collected data. The collected data cannot be linked to specific persons, it is anonymous information.

Purpose of data processing: analysis of the website.

Legal basis of data processing: consent of the data subject.

Allow or block cookies

Most browsers automatically accept cookies by default, but you can change this setting. Before disabling all cookies, you should be aware that their absence may result in damage to some website functions or services, which may not function properly without cookies.

Rights of data subjects related to data processing

The individual involved in the collection of personal data may exercise the following rights:

- Transparent information, communication and facilitation of the exercise of rights by the data subject,
- Right to prior information – where personal data are collected from the data subject,
- Informing the data subject and the information to be made available to him or her if the personal data have not been obtained from the controller,
- Right of access by the data subject,
- Right to rectification,
- Right to erasure ('right to be forgotten'),
- Right to restriction of processing,
- Notification obligation related to rectification or erasure of personal data or restriction of processing,
- Right to data portability,

- Right to object,
- Automated individual decision-making, including profiling,
- Restrictions
- Communication of the personal data breach to the data subject,
- Right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority (right to an official remedy),
- The right to an effective judicial remedy against a supervisory authority,
- The right to an effective judicial remedy against the controller or processor.

We will do our best not to hinder anyone from exercising the above rights and will be happy to help you realize them.

Upon written request, we will inform anyone about the data stored about them. You can also request the modification and deletion of stored data in writing at the following contact details: hello@thomasfodor.design

We will respond to requests received by us in writing within a short time, but in any case before the statutory deadline of one month, with details of the measure.

In the event of a possible personal data breach (an event involving a high risk to the rights and freedoms of natural persons), the Data Controller shall immediately take measures to terminate the infringement and inform the data subject and the authority without undue delay about the occurrence of the data protection incident, the scope of data subjects and the measures taken.
